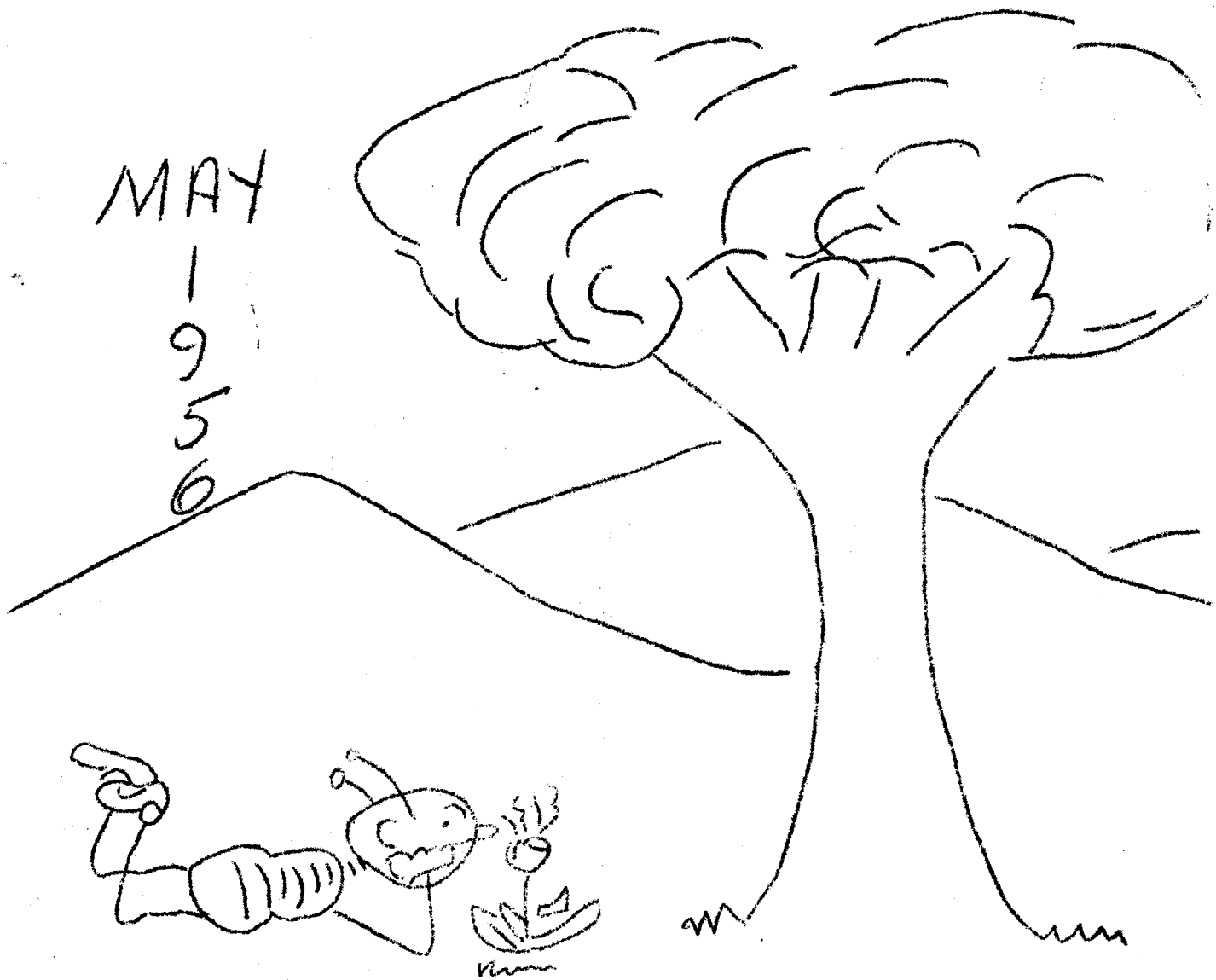

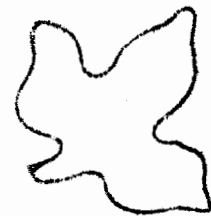

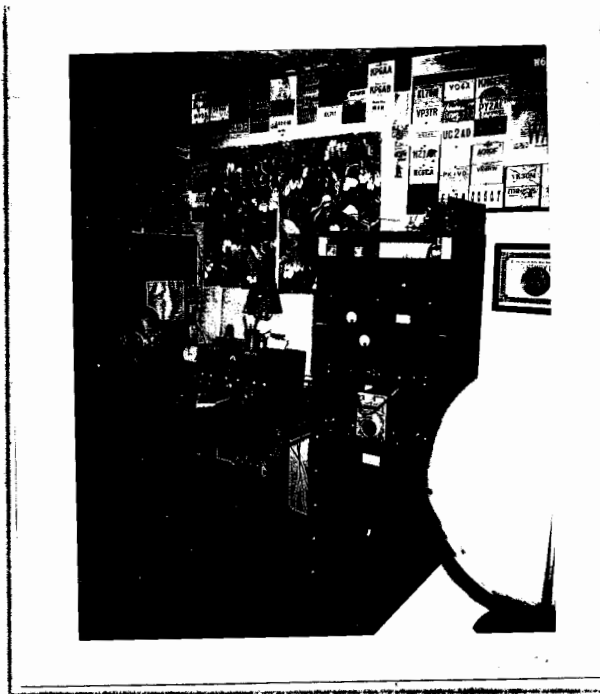

Portrayed above is the layout and personage on one of our new members, W6LGD, Clayton R. Cash, 7309 Walnut Road, Fair Oaks, Calif.

W6LGD first went on the air in August on 1934 with a powerful 8 watter, and a two tube regenerative receiver. This setup gave way to a 210 Hartely rig and just prior to the late fracas, it had progressed to a crystal controlled 100th. The pre-war DX total was 70 countries and 30 zones.

After returning to the air in 1946, the rig was a pair of 810s running 800 watts and a BC 342. Clay says he is still using the same rig (with modifications). As a matter of fact, W6LGD has two PP 810 rigs, one for 20 and the other for 40. The SX 71 shown in the photo has since been replaced by a SX 100. The antenna is a vertical Zepp. Clay has done well with this layout. The current score is 185 worked and 160 confirmed. He holds WAZ #305 and DXCC #762. He says he might well have had a much lower WAZ number, but the zone 34 QSL from SULCR was not forthcoming and he had to wait until he worked 5A3TC in 1953 for the zone 34 card. (I had the same trouble with VK1VU - ed.)

All operations at W6LGD are via Al. Clay may not have the fanciest setup we have seen, BUT he has something of which few of us can boast, an XYL who is a ham (Aleta, K6ENL) and a DX minded one at that. She has 118W and 35 Zones. Clay says it's all he can do to keep up with the pace she is setting.

As in every DX shack there are plans afoot for improvement. There is a 20 mtr. 3 element rotary in the offing, and it will be going up soon.
