For those of you who may be interested the U. S. Department of Commerce - National Bureau of Standards - Boulder, Colorado sends out weekly postal card Bulletins of the Central Radio Propagation Laboratories Radio Warning Service. You may obtain these by writing to them at the above address and having your name placed on the mailing list. I will include here the information that is included on one of these bulletins and if the club is interested I will be pleased to place the latest such bulletin in each DX'er. Since the DX'er comes out monthly and the CRPL Warnings weekly I will run the one nearest the deadline. They are as follows: (direct copy)

PL Jb' 142 CRPL Radio Warning Service September 25, 1958

Geomagnetic Forecast through 03 October 1958

The present unexpected disturbance should end by September 26th and no further disturbance is expected for the coming week. The current level of solar activity is low, although attention should be called to the present equinoctial period.

Record of Geomagnetic Activity Index, "A" - Belvoir

September 17th to 23rd: 10-04-03-05-03-07**

**In recent months the middle 33% of A-Belvoir values has been in the range ~ 10 to ~15. The "A" figure is one which increases in value with increasing degree of magnetic disturbance: A's < 05 are very quiet, A's > 25 are definitely disturbed.

I believe that these warning bulletins are a valuable asset to club members in knowing when dx conditions might be exceptionally good or very poor. Suit yourself. They're free.

As you may notice, there are now two stations active from the Maldive Islands, VS9MI and VS9MA, Vic and Don. Have QSO'ed them both within the last week or ten days and have heard VS9MA several times around 1530 to 1600 GMT.

Also QSO'ed KH6MG/ZK1. According to the Ohio Bulletin he is supposed to be on Danger Island, which is about 600 miles north of Cook Island group and ought to be a good bet for a new country.

Been fooling around a bit on 7 mc, have worked So. America and Europe in the evenings, with good S7 sigs both ways to Europe around 0300 to 0430, GMT.

Your's truly and his wife left their swim suits at the poolside and I believe that one of the members (Guy) has them. We would appreciate it if you could bring them along to the next meeting. Thanks. Reg was not present at the gathering as he is building a home in the St. Martin Islands and is spending the majority of his time there these days. According to Reg's son-in-law Reg now has five (5) stations set up in the area of St. Martins and gets on from each of them from time to time. At this rate Reg should make DXCC with tickets. He seems to have a pretty good start. Anyway the Club appreciates the hospitality Reg and hopes you can make it to the next picnic hi.

Bill Orr, W6SAI, is now in Europe with his family and word has it that Bill has a ticket for Andorra as well as the Vatican and will be on the air from both places. I saw Bill shortly before he left and he plans to try to get on from as many hard ones as possible while in Europe. He will be headquartering in Monaco where he already has a ticket.

From Don Chesser's, W4KVB, DX Bulletin #44 we note the following: "VS1BB advises of his forthcoming visit to British North Borneo." Will be on SSB if possible probably signing VS1BB/ZC5. The rig is Ted Henry's (W6UOU) little rig which has so far been used in VS1, VS2, VK9 (Cocos-Keeling), VK9 (Norfolk Island) and 4S7. Band operation 20 for 14 to 21 days.

Also from Don Chesser's DX Bulletin: DANGER ISLAND KH6MG/ZK1 and W0PBW/EK1, the former at first working only 28 mc phone and the later 21 mc SSB, started a month's operation from Danger Islands, located due north of the Cook Islands. Administered along with Cook Island by New Zealand. About 600 miles north of the Cook Islands and 750 miles east of the Tokelaus (ZM7). Should put them in a new country status. They plan to be there until October 12th.

Trinidad will become a new DXCC country Dec first; official announcement will be in October QST.
