THE CONTEST WILL BEGIN AT 0001 GMT, JAN. 1, 1965, AND END AT 0000 GMT, DEC. 31, 1965. CONTESTANTS WILL BE REQUIRED TO WORK AS MANY DIFFERENT COUNTRIES OVER 100 AS POSSIBLE IN ORDER TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR THE SPECIAL PRIZES WHICH WILL BE OFFERED BY THE LIDXA. ANY MODE-ANY BAND MAY BE USED BUT JUST ONE CONFIRMATION FROM EACH COUNTRY WILL COUNT. THE CONTEST WILL BE BASED ON ARRL DXCC RULES AND THE ARRL COUNTRIES' LIST WILL BE FOLLOWED.

THE PRIZES TO BE AWARDED TO THE WINNERS INCLUDE THE LONG ISLAND DX ASSOCIATION TROPHY, GOING TO THE TOP SCORER IN THE WORLD: SIX CONTINENTS: AND INDIVIDUAL CERTIFICATES TO BE AWARDED TO THE TOP SCORER IN EACH COUNTRY FROM WHICH ENTRIES ARE SUBMITTED AS WELL AS WINNERS IN EACH OF THE U.
