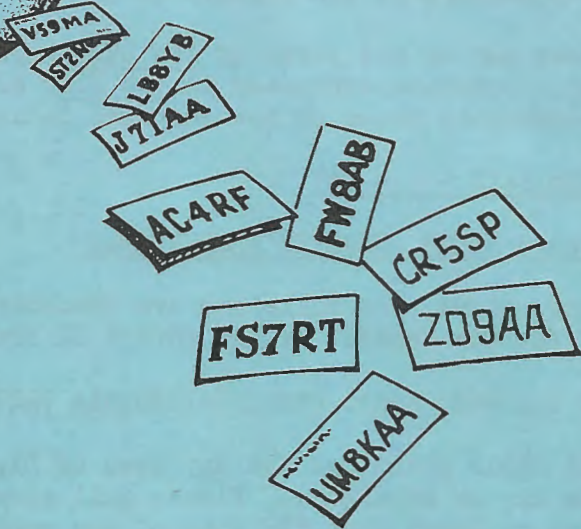

MINUTES OF NCDXC MAY MEETING

THE MAY MEETING OF THE NORTHERN CALIFORNIA DX CLUB WAS HELD FRIDAY, MAY 14, 1965 AT TADDY'S STEAK HOUSE IN SAN MATEO, THE MEETING WAS CALLED TO ORDER AT 8:03 PM. THERE WERE 29 PEOPLE PRESENT AND THE GUESTS WERE W7WJC AND K7WKW. IRIS COLVING, KL7DTB/6, REPORTED ON THE PACIFIC DIVISION MEETING AND GAVE A DETAILED REPORT OF THE VOTING. JOE REISERT, WA6TGY, REPORTED ON PLANS FOR THE JULY NCDXC MEETING TO BE HELD AT LOU'S VILLAGE ON WEST SAN CARLOS STREET IN SAN JOSE. THE COST WILL BE ABOUT \$5.00 PER PERSON AND THERE WILL BE ENTERTAINMENT AND OTHER ATTRACTIONS SUCH AS DANCING. XYLS ARE INVITED. THERE WAS DISCUSSION REGARDING THE NCDXC DX EXHIBIT AT THE FORTHCOMING NATIONAL CONVENTION. THE NEED FOR SOMEONE TO BE ON HAND AT ALL TIMES TO PROVIDE SECURITY FOR THE EXHIBIT WAS DISCUSSED. IT WAS VOTED THAT THE CLUB WOULD FINANCE THE COST OF FILM, PROJECTOR TRAYS AND OTHER ITEMS INCIDENTAL TO THE EXHIBIT. WA6ATO MADE A MOTION THAT ONLY THE SLIDES OF THE NCDXC BE SHOWN. SECONDED BY LLOYD COLVIN, W6KG, IT WAS PUT TO A VOTE AND DEFEATED. RON PANTON, W6CBE STATED THAT AS FAR AS HE WAS CONCERNED WA6TGY COULD MAKE THE DECISION. BOB THOMPSON, K6SSJ, MADE THE MOTION THAT \$50.00 BE ADVANCED TO WA6TGY FOR POSSIBLE EXHIBIT EXPENSES. MOTION SECONDED AND VOTED AFFIRMATIVE. JOE HORVATH, W6GFB, STATED THE NCDXC NOW HAS FOUR PLATES AND 400 NEW CALIFORNIA AWARD CERTIFICATES. THEY WERE MADE BY BERT YOUNG. W6KG MADE A MOTION TO PAY BERT YOUNG \$50.00 FOR THE PLATES AND CERTIFICATES AND TO INCLUDE LETTER OF APPRECIATION. MOTION SECONDED AND VOTED AFFIRMATIVE. CALIFORNIA AWARD #75 WAS ISSUED TO KL7MF. ROUND TABLE FOLLOWED AND MEETING ADJOUNED AT 10:30 PM.
