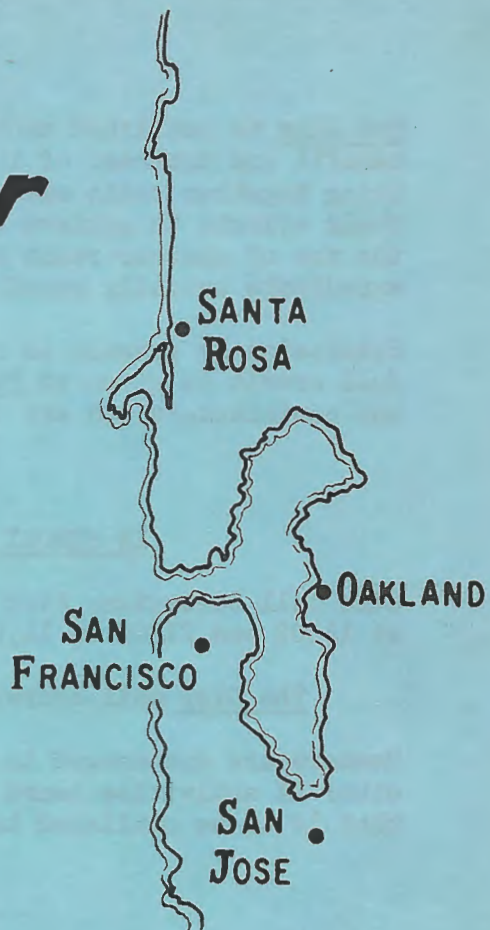
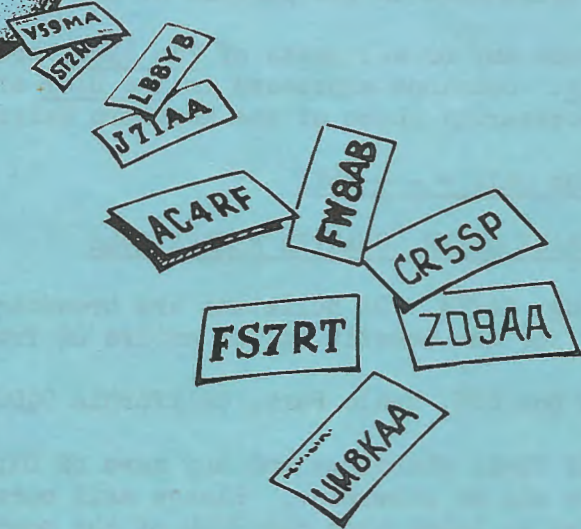

MINUTES OF NCDXC JUNE MEETING

THE JUNE MEETING OF THE NORTHERN CALIFORNIA DX CLUB WAS HELD AT TADDY'S STEAK HOUSE IN SAN MATEO ON JUNE 11, 1965, AND WAS CALLED TO ORDER AT 9:00 PM. GUESTS WERE JALDCY AND W46AJE. W6KG SPOKE ON THE EXHIBITS AND W6UMI STATED THAT HE UNDERSTOOD TWO PENTA 4-400 A'S WOULD BE THE PRIZE AT THE CLUB MEETING. VE7BFN WILL BE COMING DOWN FOR THE DOINGS. FOLLOWING THE BUSINESS SESSION, NOMINATION AND ELECTION OF OFFICERS WAS HELD. THE NEW OFFICERS ARE: PRESIDENT: JACK BROLLIER, K6ERV; VICE PRESIDENT: JIM NEIGER, W7WJV; SEC/TREAS: RAY EICHMAN, W46IVM. FOLLOWING THE ROUND TABLE, THE MEETING ADJOURNED AT 10:40 PM.

RESPECTFULLY SUBMITTED, RAY EICHMAN, W46IVM, SEC/TREAS.

THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE NCDXC MIGHT BE INTERESTED IN CERTAIN PROPOSALS BEING BROUGHT OUT TO THE ARRL BY THE SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA CLUBS. THEIR VOTING WILL BE PUBLISHED NEXT MONTH, BUT PERHAPS SOME OF OUR MEMBERS WOULD CARE TO SEND IN THEIR VIEWS AND VOTES ON THESE PROPOSED CHANGES IN THE DX CONTEST RULES AND DXCC. FOLLOWING ARE THEIR RECOMENDATIONS:

PROPOSED CHANGES FOR ARRL DX CONTEST RULES

- 1. ELIMINATION ENTIRELY OF THE QUOTA SYSTEM.
2. CHANGE OF DURATION OF THE CONTEST FROM TWO WEEKENDS PER MODE TO ONE WEEKEND PER MODE, WITH ONE MONTH DURATION BETWEEN CONTESTS.
3. CHANGE THE USA REPORT SYSTEM FROM RST AND STATE TO RST AND ARRL SECTION, IN ORDER TO BALANCE MULTIPLIERS MORE EVENLY BETWEEN THE EAST AND WEST COAST.
4. REDUCE THE NUMBER OF POINTS GIVEN TO A FOREIGN STATION FOR A W OR VE CONTACT FROM 3 TO 2, IN ORDER TO REDUCE THE INCREASE IN SCORE DUE TO A MULTIPLIER INCREASE.
5. OPEN SINGLE BAND ENTRIES IN THE ARRL CONTEST.
6. COORDINATION BETWEEN QST AND CQ MAGAZINES AS REGARDS THE SCHEDULING AND PUBLICITY OF CONTESTS, AND THE SCHEDULING OF ALL CONTESTS TO AVOID HOLIDAYS AND CONVENTIONS.
7. ELIMINATE BAND REFERENCE IN CONTESTS, THAT IS, OPEN ALL BANDS 2 MC THROUGH 10 KMC, FOR CONTEST PARTICIPATION.
8. DISCONTINUE THE POWER OF THE OO TO DISQUALIFY AN ENTRANT ON THE BASIS OF TWO REPORTS, AND DEVELOPE A DIFFERENT SYSTEM OF SELF-POLICING, POSSIBLY TIED TO LOCAL INSPECTIONS, FOR INSTANCE.
9. LIMITATION OF THE TOTAL OPERATING TIME IN THE CONTEST FOR SINGLE OPERATOR STATIONS TO 72 HOURS MAXIMUM, WITH AS MANY AS FOUR REST PERIODS ALLOWED.

PROPOSED CHANGES FOR DXCC RULES.

1. RECOGNITION OF LICENSING IN THE NORMAL MANNER ONLY WHEN THE LICENSING AUTHORITIES WHOSE GOVERNMENTS ARE IN CONTROL OF THE AREA ARE RECOGNIZED FORMALLY BY THE UNITED STATES GOVERNMENT. IN CASES WHERE THE UNITED STATES DOES NOT RECOGNIZE THE LICENSING GOVERNMENT, ANY OPERATION IN THE AREA WOULD CONSTITUTE CREDIT.
2. VIEWPOINT ON STARTING DXCC OVER FROM SCRATCH.
3. STATE THAT NO CHANGE IN GENERAL GROUND RULES GOVERNING COUNTRY STATUS CRITERIA SHALL BECOME EFFECTIVE UNTIL THE MONTH FOLLOWING THE PUBLICATION DATE OF THE PROPOSED CHANGE IN OST.
4. SEPARATE CREDIT FOR GEOGRAPHICAL ISLAND GROUPS UNDER THE SAME ADMINISTRATION WHEN GREATER THAN 225 MILES SEPARATES THE NEAREST ISLANDS OF THE TWO GROUPS.
5. CHANGE THE SYSTEM FOR DECIDING DXCC STATUS BY MODIFYING THE DXCC COMMITTEE TO A MEMBERSHIP OF 9, 5 OF WHICH SHALL BE MEMBERS OF THE HONOR ROLL, REPRESENTING 5 DIFFERENT CALL AREAS. EACH MEMBER OF THE COMMITTEE WOULD VOTE ON QUESTIONS OF COUNTRY STATUS BY MAIL, AND A SIMPLE MAJORITY OF THE COMMITTEE WOULD DECIDE THE ISSUE.

AREAS OF GENERAL INTEREST

1. REINSTATEMENT OF FULL DXCC CREDIT TO A SUSPENDED AMATEUR AFTER THE TERM OF SUSPENSION.
2. (A) THE ARRL SHOULD LOBBY TO TIE TO INCENTIVE LICENSING A PROVISION THAT EXTRA CLASS LICENSEES HAVE UNLIMITED POWER RESTRICTIONS, PROVIDED ALL SUCH LICENSE HOLDERS DESIRING TO OPERATE TRANSMITTERS OF INPUT POWER GREATER THAN 5 KW SUBMIT PLANS OF THE EQUIPMENT TO THE FCC, ALONG WITH A SUITABLE FEE TO DEFER EXPENSES, AND THAT ALL SUCH LICENSE HOLDERS DESIRING TO RUN OVER 5 KW SUBMIT TO A RIG CHECK BY THE FCC IN ORDER TO ASSURE PROPER TECHNICAL STANDARDS HAVE BEEN OBSERVED IN THE DESIGN, CONSTRUCTION, AND OPERATION OF THE EQUIPMENT.
(B) THE ARRL SHOULD LOBBY TO ELIMINATE ENTIRELY THE POWER LIMIT.
THE END.

WELL-----WHAT DO ALL OF YOU GENTLEMEN THINK? MY FIRST REACTION IS TO SUGGEST THE POWER LIMIT FOR EXTRA CLASS LICENSE HOLDERS BE LOWERED TO 100 OR 150 WATTS. AFTER ALL, IF WE (AND I DO HAVE ONE) DO GET THE LOWER ENDS OF THE BANDS, WE SHOULDN'T NEED 5 KW AND MORE.

TWO VERY FINE GENTLEMEN. A CREDIT TO HAM RADIO AND THE NCDXC. MY HEARTIEST CONGRATULATIONS TO THE NEW REGIME, AND THE CLUB. OUR OVER-WORKED SECRETARY-TREASURER WAS RE-ELECTED AND TO HIM MY THANKS FOR ALL THE WORK NECESSARY TO KEEP THAT JOB GOING. I'M SPEAKING OF RAY EICHMAN, W6GIVM. I'VE ENJOYED BEING PRESIDENT FOR THE LAST YEAR, AND HOPE MR. ROBERTS OF ROBERTS RULES WASN'T TOO OFFENDED AT MY AMATEURISH ERRORS IN RULES OF ORDER.
